### How to use this booklet

Once you have taken your Spiritual Gifts test and read up on the descriptions, it's time to match your gifts with service possibilities.

- 1. Find some time to pray over the booklet and your spiritual gifts before embarking on this next step. We firmly believe God will guide you to just the right opportunity that fits your gifts, passions, and gets you excited to serve.
- 2. Take your top 3 spiritual gifts and find them in the booklet. The booklet is in alphabetical order by gifts.
- 3. Look through each list and find any service opportunities that match at least 2 of the gifts, if not all three. If you have a paper copy of the booklet you can take notes of service opportunities that are in common in the back. Otherwise, a scratch sheet of paper may be helpful.
- 4. We suspect that those ones that are in common among at least 2 of your gifts would fit you the best as opportunities. Pray over these possibilities and then pick as few or as many as you would like to try over the next few months.
  - a. If none of those interest you, but you find others that may, then feel free to prayerfully consider those.
- 5. Once you have picked your serving options, we want you to sign up! In the back of the booklet is an index with all the serving opportunities broken up into categories. Locate your option(s) and then head to the **Next Steps Tab** on the Trinity website (trinityruston.org) and click on **Join A Team**.
- 6. Fill Out the form and submit. The team leader of that service opportunity will contact you within 48 hours.
- 7. Keep an eye out for our Serving Commitment Cards where you will record what your commitment to serve is for the rest of the year. We will receive these cards on Confirmation Sunday, April 24th at both services.

Colossians 1:9
